

STATEMENT/PURPOSE: To consider approval of the Abstract of votes at the City of Mandan Special Election held June 9, 2015.

The City Canvassing Board will meet on Monday, June 15, 2015 to consider the abstract of votes. The City Canvassing Board consists of Mayor Van Beek, Commissioners Tibke and Rohr, City Attorney Brown, City Administrator/Auditor Neubauer

Votes Cast as determined by the Inspectors and Judges at the June 9, 2015 City of Mandan Special Election:

Yes	1,569
No	<u>1,222</u>
Total	2,792

There are three absentee ballots that were not counted. These ballots were completed prior to an error being discovered on the ballot. Contact was made to the voters asking informing them of the error and asking if they wished to amend their vote. Voicemails were left and no response was received.

The Canvassing Board will need to determine how they wish to treat the three absentee ballots.

Option A: If wish to include such votes in the abstract a motion will need to be made to open and include them in the vote totals.

If that motion is made we will then need to:

- a) Make a motion to approve the revised vote totals.
- b) Certify the revised vote totals and in turn pass them on to the City Commission.

Option B: If the three votes are not considered, then simply certify the vote totals as above and pass them on to the City Commission.
