## **Monument Regulations**

- Monuments must face east.
- Monuments must be placed at the head end of the grave in line with surrounding monuments.
- Additional monuments may be placed at the middle or foot end of the grave as long as the additional monument is a flat marker that is set flush with the ground.
- Monuments must set on a cement, granite or marble pad that is 4" in thickness. The monument pad must create a 4"-8" gutter that surrounds the monument base.
- The monument pad must set flush with the ground.
- A monument pad for a single grave may not exceed a width of 48 inches.
- A monument pad for double graves may not exceed a width of 60 inches.
- Monuments may not exceed a height of 4 feet.
- Monument crosses may not exceed a width of 3 feet.
- Ground covers for graves are not allowed.
- Only flat markers are allowed in the cremation section located in Block 9.
- Monuments may not be installed after business hours without permission from cemetery staff. Business hours are Monday through Friday from 7:30 am to 4:00 pm.
- Any monument that does not meet the cemetery monument regulations must be approved by cemetery staff prior to installation.



## MANDAN UNION CEMETERY

- Open from 7 a.m. to sunset.
- Vehicles restricted to established roads.
- Pets welcome. Must be leashed. Please clean up after them.
- Not responsible for damaged or missing items.
- No food or drink items left at grave sites.
- No Permanent plantings.
- Monument base must remain unobstructed. No borders or rocks.
- No commemorative items, unless attached as an integral part of headstone (includes benches).
- Fresh flowers allowed on grave any time (no wrapping, plastic or glass containers).
- Fresh or artificial floral items allowed anytime if in vases attached to headstones.
- Maintenance staff reserves right to remove items.
