### **Trustee vacancies**

The Morton Mandan Public Library Board of Trustees has four volunteer positions available. Must be a resident of Morton County, attend monthly board meetings, and advocate for library issues. The Board is comprised of eight members: three residents of the County and three residents of the City of Mandan, along with an appointee each from the County and City Commissions. Current vacant positions are a three-year term from July 2015 through June 2018. In order to achieve equal representation, preference for two County representatives will be given to a Morton County resident in New Salem and Hebron. The other two vacancies must be filled by City of Mandan residents. Volunteers may serve two consecutive three-year terms. However, volunteers wishing to serve a second term, must submit a letter of interest as well.

### **Position involves the following responsibilities:**

- Attend all regularly scheduled, and special board meetings (held the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of each month);
- Come to meetings prepared, having read relevant information;
- Be available to serve on board committees;
- Be familiar with the board's bylaws and library policies, along with enforcement of these guidelines;
- Visit library frequently to enough to be familiar with services and see potential needs;
- Be an advocate for the library with civic groups, community leaders, and public officials;
- Attend library events throughout the year (i.e. NDLA).
