General Overview:


Mariner Construction is nearing the completion of the Southside Street Reconstruction project, and is expected to be finished by the end of July. The attached map will be updated every two weeks to try give the public an idea of which type of improvements will be happening throughout the neighborhood.

What To Expect:

- There will be temporary closures . If you see “road closed” signs, please plan to park on the street.
- Garbage and Recycling services will continue as regularly scheduled. Contact the on-site engineer at 651-328-3354 if you need help.
- Landscaping and seeding will continue for several weeks.
- The contractor has a punch list of work to get completed.
- Parking lots will be striped at the end of July.
- Please be careful to avoid construction equipment, as they don't always see you!
- If you have sprinklers that have been damaged, please notify the on-site engineer.
- Clarification: On-site construction at the Public Works Facility is not a part of the Southside Project and will be ongoing throughout the fall.

The Next Two Weeks:

- The remaining alley paving will be completed within the next 2 weeks.
- Starting on July 6th, all streets will be chip sealed.
- If you have newly seeded grass in your yard, please water it!
