**C. Consider changes to be made to Article 4 Section 16 and Section 115 in the Mandan Municipal Code**

- *Went through changes that were made to the city ordinance pertaining to trees/vegetation*
- *Nichols suggested that I speak with the fire and police dept to see if they want to increase planting distance to more than 40'*
- *Ames-Davis said that for busy intersections she may increase to more than 40'*
- *Ames-Davis suggested adding "public nuisance" in definitions*
- *Change Article 4 to Dutch Elm Disease, emerald ash borer and Other invasive species*
- *Nichols mentioned that the varieties of elm that are now available that are DED resistant bear seeds. Change that in Sec. 16-4-8 subarticle 6 to DED resistant species only.*
- *Nichols mentioned that Wayne Beyer from Whqpeton has an EAB management plan that I can use to make our own management plan. There is also a Tree Emergency Response Plan can be used also.*
