

# PROJECT UPDATE

## Mandan, North Dakota

### Mid-Town East Project

for the weeks of  
**7.13 & 7.20**  
2020

The City of Mandan has hired Mariner Construction to complete the Mid-Town East reconstruction project. This project will be completed in stages throughout the summer with the areas shown in the attached map to begin first. Generally, the order of construction will be as follows: 1. Remove old streets, 2. Pipe installation, 3. Concrete work, 4. Aggregate base reconstruction, 5. Asphalt Paving, 6. Restoration/Seeding, 7. Chip Sealing and Pavement Markings (2021)

### What To Expect:

- Expect some dust, noise and minor inconveniences normally associated with construction.
- Working hours will likely be from around 7 a.m. — 7 p.m., 5 days per week
- In the areas where water main is being replaced, there could be temporary water pipes strung out above ground into yards.
- Many of the old water valves do not work and the old pipes are brittle. Expect some disruptions in water service.
- Traffic control barricades will be placed to protect both travelers and workers.
- Isolated street closures will be temporary, but may last a few days. Roadways will re-open with a temporary gravel surface until they are paved.
- Garbage service will continue on your normal day. If your street is closed to traffic on that day, you may need to roll your garbage can to the end of the block. Contact on-site engineer if you have questions.
- Please be careful to avoid construction equipment, as they don't always see you!
- If you have sprinklers that have been damaged, please notify the on-site engineer.

### The Next Two Weeks:

- Pipeline crews will replace water main and sewer mains in the areas shown on the attached map.
- Major traffic will be detoured around areas. Local traffic will be allowed in.
- Concrete crews will be replacing segments of curb, sidewalk and driveway beginning next week.
- Weather permitting, several blocks along 3rd Ave will be cement treated and re-opened to traffic next week!
- Construction will be taking place on two sides of St. Joes. You may need to utilize alternate parking areas temporarily.
- Expect many streets to have gravel surfaces. Watch for dips and drive slow!
