

CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Memorial Highway construction will begin around April 1. Traffic will be reduced to a single lane in each direction during construction, the speed will be lowered to 25 mph, and there will be an 11-foot width restriction.

Memorial Highway will be reconstructed from 32nd Avenue Southeast to 46th Avenue Southeast as part of the 2025 construction season. The project includes replacing the existing surfacing with new concrete pavement, improving drainage, installing underground utilities, and a new multi-use path for bicyclists and pedestrians.

Other improvements include upgraded traffic signals, lighting, improved access for businesses, and drainage enhancements. The east half of the Memorial Highway reconstruction is expected to be completed by mid-November, and the east side multi-use path is scheduled for completion in 2026.

UPCOMING WORK

Project improvements include construction of an underground storm sewer trunk line that will cross 21st Street Southeast and 19th Street Southeast. Information regarding street closures and proposed detour routes will be available on the City of Mandan's project website, accessible via the link and QR code below.

ABOUT THE PROJECT

The City of Mandan, partnering with the North Dakota Department of Transportation, has launched a two-phase reconstruction of Memorial Highway from Main Street to the Memorial Bridge that will occur from 2025 to 2027. The project will improve the Memorial Highway corridor with a new concrete surface, a new storm sewer system, and updated bicycle and pedestrian facilities. It will also involve upgrading underground sanitary sewer and water lines and burying above-ground utility lines.

KEY PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE:

- Add sidewalks or trails
- Improve traffic flow and intersection safety
- Improve drainage
- Provide safe access to businesses
- Address pavement at the end of useful life
