

MANDAN REMEDIATION TRUST (MRT)

The MRT meeting was called to order with Jim Neubauer, Francis Schwindt and Dave Glatt from the North Dakota Department of Environmental Health as Trustees.

Minutes. MRT minutes from the May 7, 2019 meeting were previously reviewed.

Motion. Schwindt moved to approve minutes of May 7, 2019, and seconded by Glatt. All ayes. Motion carried.

WSP Spring Monitoring Event. Results of recent monitoring indicates that they hadn't found free product in as many areas as they have in the past, so results were positive. Another monitoring event should be done at the end of June or beginning of July. If the results show the same trend, there should be serious consideration of shutting things down.

Schwindt will begin contacting property owners find out what they want to do with the wells in their buildings.

Discussed whether there is a need for agreements from the property owners indicating they are satisfied that the project is complete, and they are okay with dismantling their well, and that they give permission to remove it; and then a final document indicating this has been completed. Neubauer will talk with Malcolm and have him draft up the paperwork.

Schwindt wondered if bids should be sought for replacing concrete and asphalt for patching the streets and sidewalks where the wells are pulled out. It was suggested that time be spent over the winter coming up with a list of things that will need to be completed next spring, including pulling the concrete pad out of the park and bringing in black dirt & sod.

Neubauer suggested compiling a list of all the wells and the status of each as they are plugged or closed since the Department of Environmental Quality will want that.

Schwindt questioned whether Water Supply should be contacted about removing some of those wells in the basements this year or wait until next year.

Steve Himmelsbach asked Neubauer if he would present at the State Water Pollution Conference in Bismarck this fall.
