This year, Mandan is participating in an exciting opportunity led by the North Dakota Department of Transportation to plan, implement, and evaluate a street demonstration project within our community.

What are demonstration projects?

Demonstration projects are short-term, low-cost, and highly flexible ways to test run and experience potential street improvement design solutions that promote active transportation, safety enhancements, and promote healthy and vibrant communities.

Project

The project aims to install artistic crosswalks, curb extensions, and a mini-roundabout during the temporary project this summer.

Location: 1st Street between 3rd Avenue and 4th Avenue; Main Street between 3rd Avenue and 4th Avenue.

Duration: July 12 to August 9, 2018

Making it Happen: Process

Mandan will be engaging with NDDOT and project consultants over the course of the spring, summer, and fall of 2018.

May – June 2018:

- Discuss the project with the community
- Draft and finalize project plans

July 2018:

- Demonstration project implementation

July – September 2018:

- Evaluation of demonstration projects

August – September 2018:

- Advocacy strategy for permanent change
