43rd Ave SE Update

Crews completed temporary concrete placement in the 43rd Ave SE area to provide a hard, drivable surface for the winter months.

- This concrete is temporary and was placed to support winter traffic and access.
- It is not the final surface and will be removed and replaced as part of the permanent roadway construction next year.

Any cracking that occurs over the winter is expected and does not represent the final product.

Winter Traffic Control in Place

Winter traffic control is now set for the season:

- Permanent and temporary signs have been mounted throughout the corridor.
- Pavement markings have been reapplied from 43rd Ave SE to 32nd Ave SE to improve clarity and safety.
- Drivers are encouraged to follow posted signage and adjust speeds for winter conditions.

These measures will remain in place until construction resumes in the spring.

Looking Ahead to 2026

Planning for the 2026 construction season is already underway.

In early January, NDDOT, Reede Construction Inc, and project subcontractors will meet to finalize the 2026 schedule, including work sequencing, resources, and crew assignments.
