Memorial Highway Construction Update

As the 2025 construction season comes to a close, crews are making final preparations to transition Memorial Highway into its winter traffic control configuration.

Winter Traffic Control

Crews are finalizing the roadway and traffic control measures that will remain in place through the winter months. Here's what to expect:

- **West End Pavement Markings:** Some existing pavement markings on the west end of the project will be removed to help avoid driver confusion through the winter.
- **40th Ave SE Turn Lanes:** Crews will add lane-use signs on the overhead wire to clarify that turning traffic should use the center lane.
- **39th Ave Access:** Memorial Highway access to 39th Ave SE will be closed for the winter. The east Lonesome Dove parking lot entrance will be open with access to 39th going south.
- **Signage & Staking:** NDDOT will stake locations for STOP signs, Center Lane Turn Only signs, Speed Limit 25 signs, and Stop Here on Red signs as needed. Coordination is underway to ensure all signs are properly placed.
- **Pedestrian Movement:** At 46th Ave SE, pedestrian barricades will be removed and Reede Construction will reroute pedestrian access for the winter.
- **At the Lonesome Dove area,** pedestrian barricades may remain in place through winter unless barriers are needed for added protection.
- **Curblin Traffic Tubes:** Crews are backfilling behind the curb. Once this work is complete, tubes will be installed along the south side as required to assist with plowing operations.

Snow Removal Reminder

Please remember: Do not push snow into the roadway or project right-of-way. Doing so can block sightlines, interfere with traffic control devices, and impact plowing operations. Property owners should keep snow on their own lots or arrange for offsite hauling.
