The City is seeing a higher than normal accumulation of grease in the sewer pipes which can lead to sewer back-ups.

How does the grease get into your sewer?

When you put cooking waste (grease, oil, food scraps) down the drain, it clings to the sides of the sewer pipes leading to clogged pipes and sewer back-ups.

FIGHT THE GREASE!

- The proper way to get rid of grease is to pour it into a tin can, let it cool, and then throw the can into the trash.
- Throw food waste into the trash, not down the drain.
- Recycle used non-contaminated fryer oils, free of charge at The Mandan Landfill located at 4103 Co Rd 82.
